The Care & Repair Movement covers the whole of Wales. The feedback and case studies from our clients helps us maintain the highest quality. It also helps to shape the services that are available on a national level.

Here are two examples of changes made to policy as a result:

NEST – previously, homes on farms were not eligible for support with upgrading heating, despite people living in cold conditions which exacerbated health conditions.

When the new Warm Homes Programme launched in April 2024, it included people living on farms for the first time.

Through the Older Not Colder project, it was identified that the lengthy ‘fabric first’ approach of the **Warm Homes scheme** did not meet the needs of older people who needed a quick fix. Case studies led to the introduction of a crisis route for vulnerable clients which helped pay for urgent boiler repairs or replacement boilers.

Care & Repair Cymru are campaigning for a national **Safety Net Grant**. This would support homeowners to get essential repairs undertaken before they worsen and impact on peoples’ health.

Dyma ddwy enghraifft o newidiadau a wnaed i bolisi o ganlyniad:

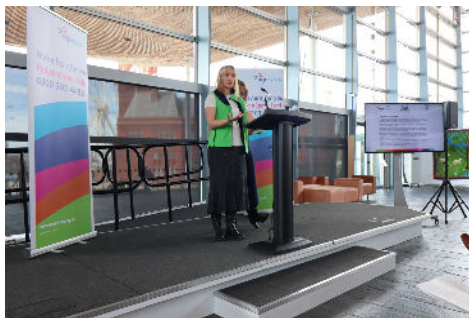
NEST – yn flaenorol, nid oedd cartrefi ar ffermydd yn gymwys i gael cymorth gydag uwchraddio gwresogi, er gwaethaf y ffaith fod pobl yn byw mewn amodau oer a oedd yn gwaethygu cyflyrau iechyd. Pan lansiwyd y Rhaglen Cartrefi Clyd newydd ym mis Ebrill 2024, roedd yn cynnwys pobl sy'n byw ar ffermydd am y tro cyntaf.

Drwy'r prosiect Hynach Nid Oerach, nodwyd nad oedd dull hirfaith 'ffabrig yn gyntaf' y **cynllun Cartrefi Clyd** yn diwallu anghenion pobl hŷn a oedd angen ateb cyflym. Arweiniodd astudiaethau achos at gyflwyno llwybr argyfwng ar gyfer cleientiaid agored i niwed a helpodd i dalu am atgyweiriadau boeleri brys neu foeleri newydd.

Mae Gofal a Thrwsio Cymru yn ymgyrchu dros Grant Rhwyd Ddiogelwch cenedlaethol. Byddai hyn yn cefnogi perchnogion tai i gael atgyweiriadau hanfodol wedi'u gwneud cyn iddynt waethygu ac effeithio ar iechyd pobl.

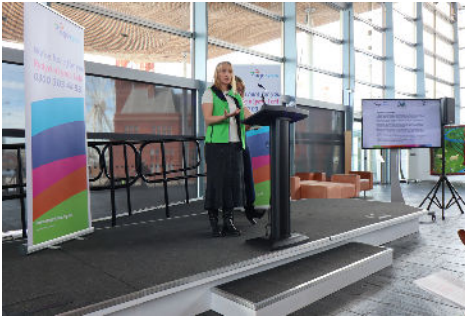
Care & Repair Ambassadors are individuals who are happy to speak openly about their experiences so more people hear about our services and so that older people's voices are heard by those in power in Wales.

- a functionality test of telecare equipment
- an assessment for telecare equipment
- support with self assessment and purchase of equipment to reduce the risk of falls.
- onward referral for other services and information

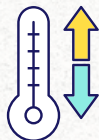
Mamwlad
